Code of Conduct

For Coaches, Players and Non-Players

1. Never verbally abuse or criticize players, coaches, umpires, or officials in front of other league members or spectators.
2. Never criticize, belittle, antagonize or otherwise incite an opposing team, it's players, coaches or spectators, or umpires by word of mouth or gesture.
3. Dissatisfaction with players, coaches, umpires or league officials shall be addressed through proper channels and NOT through social media.
4. Consumption of alcohol on or near the field of play is NOT allowed.
5. Bullying or threatening bodily harm to any league member, officials, umpires or spectators is forbidden.
6. Coaches shall exhibit professionalism in their actions and words.
7. Never aggressively protest an official's call in a manner which might incite a violent or aggressive confrontation.
8. Always place the emotional and physical well-being of a player ahead of any personal desire to win.
9. No individual shall be guilty using unnecessary rough tactics on the field of play.
10. Never demonstrate unsportsmanlike conduct before, during or after league or tournament play.
11. Always treat all members of our league and other NAGAAA leagues with dignity and respect.
